**TERMS OF USE**



**1. AGREEMENT.**

These terms of use are entered into by and between you (“**you**”) and BASE Education, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (“**we**” or “**BASE**” or “**BASE Education**”). The following terms and conditions, together with any documents they expressly incorporate by reference (collectively, “**Terms of Use**”), govern your access to and use of the BASE software-as-a-service offerings, including the BASE social emotional learning software program, BASE Materials (as defined below) and other content provided by BASE, including the functionality and services offered on or through the BASE Education website, whether as a guest, Licensee, or Authorized User (both as defined below). We reserve the right to change or amend these Terms of Use without notice. See the Section titled “Changes to the Terms of Use” below for details.

Please read the Terms of Use carefully before you start to use the BASE Materials. **By using the BASE Materials, you accept and agree to be bound and abide by these Terms of Use and our Privacy Policy, available at <http://www.base.education/privacy-policy>, incorporated herein by reference.** By using the BASE Materials, you consent to all actions taken by us with respect to your information in compliance with the Privacy Policy. If you do not want to agree to these Terms of Use or the Privacy Policy, you must not access or use the BASE Materials.

If you have purchased access to the BASE Materials through a License and Terms of Purchase Agreement, alone or in conjunction with an Order Form, then these Terms of Use work in conjunction with, and are in addition to, your License and Terms of Purchase Agreement.

By reviewing, installing and/or using the BASE Materials, you indicate that you have read, understood and agree to be bound by all of the terms and conditions set forth herein.

**2. DEFINITIONS.**

(a) “**Access Credentials**” means any user name, identification number, password, license or security key, security token, PIN, or other security code, method, technology, or device used, alone or in combination, to verify an individual’s identity and authorization to access and use the Services.

(b) “**Aggregated Data**” means data and information related to your use of the Services that is used by BASE in an aggregate and anonymized manner, including to compile statistical and performance information related to the provision and operation of the Services. Aggregated Data does not include personally identifiable information and/or education records as defined pursuant to 24 CFR § 99.3 and 20 U.S.C. § 1232g(a)(4)(B).

(c) “**Authorized Users**” means any person, including students, parents, employees, consultants, contractors, agents, representatives, or other individuals (i) who use or access the Services; (ii) are authorized by BASE or by Licensee to access and use the Services; or (iii) for whom access to the Services has been purchased.

(d) “**BASE Systems**” means the information technology infrastructure used by or on behalf of BASE in performing the Services, including all computers, Services, hardware, databases,

electronic systems (including database management systems), websites, and networks, whether operated directly by BASE or through the use of third-party services.

(e) **“BASE Materials”** means the Services, Documentation, and BASE Systems and any and all other information, data, documents, materials, works, and other content, devices, methods, processes, hardware, Services, and other technologies and inventions, including any deliverables, technical or functional descriptions, requirements, plans, or reports, that are provided or used by BASE or any subcontractor in connection with the Services or that otherwise comprise or relate to the Services or BASE Systems. For the avoidance of doubt, BASE Materials includes all content or other material made available through the Services including surveys, assessments, question and answer sessions, modules, lectures, speeches, video lessons, quizzes, presentation materials, homework assignments, programs, code, and other images, text, layouts, arrangements, displays, illustrations, documents, materials, audio and video clips, HTML and files. BASE Materials also includes Aggregated Data and any information, data, or other content derived from BASE’s monitoring of your access to or use of the Services.

(f) **“Documentation”** means BASE instructions, user manuals, handbooks, and guides relating to the Services provided by BASE either electronically or in hard copy form and includes end user documentation relating to the Services available on BASE’s website.

(g) **“Licensee”** means you, if you are the purchaser of access to the Base Materials or if you have executed a License and Terms of Purchase Agreement, or your corporation, governmental organization, or other legal entity that has purchased access to the Base Materials and/or has executed a License and Terms of Purchase Agreement to permit you to access and use of the Base Materials.

(h) **“Order Form”** means an order form executed by you or an invoice sent to you by BASE in response to your creation of an account or request to use the Services.

(i) **“Services”** means the software-as-a-service offerings, the associated computer program and all modules, updates, modifications, enhancements, or new versions thereto, and the BASE Materials, including the BASE program, surveys, assessments, tools, course, and other content provided by BASE as may be further specified in an Order Form.

### **3. CHANGES TO THE TERMS OF USE.**

We may revise and update these Terms of Use from time to time in our sole discretion. All changes are effective immediately when we post them and apply to all access to and use of the BASE Materials thereafter. Your continued use of the BASE Materials following the posting of revised Terms of Use means that you accept and agree to the changes. You should review these Terms of Use often to stay informed of changes, as they are binding upon you. If you have registered with us and provided us with an email address, we may provide you with notice informing you that these Terms of Use have changed, but such notice shall be for convenience only and shall not be required for the effectiveness of the changes. BASE Education may also make changes to the BASE Materials, including discontinuing any Service or content, or otherwise restricting access and use. We reserve the right to do so without prior notice to you.

### **4. USER ACCOUNT, ACCESS CREDENTIALS, AND SECURITY.**

We reserve the right to withdraw or amend the BASE Materials, and any service or material we provide in connection with the BASE Materials, in our sole discretion without notice. We also reserve the right to refuse access or service to any person or entity for any or no reason whatsoever. We will not be liable if for any reason all or any part of the BASE Materials is unavailable at any time or for any period. From time to

time, we may restrict access to some parts of the BASE Materials, or the entire BASE Materials, to users, including Authorized Users.

You are responsible for making all arrangements necessary for you to have access to the BASE Materials and ensuring that all persons who access the BASE Materials through your internet connection are aware of these Terms of Use and comply with them.

To purchase some specific Services for yourself or your Authorized Users, you will be required to execute a License and Terms of Purchase Agreement, alone or in conjunction with an Order Form. You expressly acknowledge and agree that such Flags are intended to be helpful but are not in lieu of your review of the information provided by a user. **BASE MAKES NO GUARANTEE OF THE ACCURACY, RELIABILITY, OR AVAILABILITY OF SUCH FLAGS. YOU HEREBY ACCEPT ALL RISK AND LIABILITY IN CONNECTION WITH YOUR RELIANCE OR USE OF SUCH FLAGS.**

## **5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS.**

The BASE Materials and all related content, Aggregated Data, features, and functionality (including but not limited to all information, software, text, displays, images, video, and audio, and the design, selection, and arrangement thereof) are owned by BASE Education, its licensors, or other providers of such material and are protected by United States and international copyright, trademark, patent, trade secret, and other intellectual property or proprietary rights laws.

Subject to these Terms of Use, the Privacy Policy, and the License and Terms of Purchase Agreement, BASE may monitor your use of the Services and collect and compile Aggregated Data based on any data or other information that you input into the Services. You agree that BASE may use and make Aggregated Data available to third parties solely in compliance with applicable law, provided that such Aggregated Data does not contain any confidential information, personal data, or other information that could identify you or any particular individual. As between BASE and you, BASE owns all right, title, and interest, including all intellectual property rights, in and to the Services, Documentation, and Aggregated Data. You have no right, license, or authorization with respect to any of the Services, Documentation, or Aggregated Data except as expressly authorized by BASE. All other rights are expressly reserved by BASE. In furtherance of the foregoing, you hereby unconditionally and irrevocably grants to BASE an assignment of any right, title, and interest (that you may have or later obtain, by operation of law or otherwise) in or to the Aggregated Data, and any derivative works created under or in connection with these Terms of Use, including all intellectual property rights relating thereto. To the extent that such right, title, or interest cannot be assigned to BASE pursuant to this Section, you grant to BASE a non-exclusive, perpetual, irrevocable, royalty-free, worldwide license to reproduce, distribute, modify, and otherwise use and display the Aggregated Data or derivative works.

You shall cooperate and take such actions or provide such assurances, at no cost to BASE, as may be necessary to give full effect to these Terms of Use.

These Terms of Use permit you to use the BASE Materials for your personal, non-commercial or educational use only. You must not reproduce, distribute, modify, create derivative works of, publicly display, publicly perform, republish, download, store, or transmit any of the BASE Materials, except as follows: (a) your computer may temporarily store copies of such materials in RAM incidental to your accessing and viewing those materials; (b) you may store files that are automatically cached by your Web browser for display enhancement purposes; or (c) you may print or download one copy of a reasonable number of pages of the BASE Materials for your own personal, non-commercial or educational use and not for further reproduction, publication, or distribution. You must not use such marks without the prior written permission of BASE Education. All other names, logos, product and service names, designs, and slogans included in the BASE Materials, if any, are the trademarks of their respective owners.

## **7. PROHIBITED USES.**

You may use the BASE Materials only for lawful purposes and in accordance with these Terms of Use. You agree not to use the BASE Materials:

(a) In any way that violates any applicable federal, state, local, or international law or regulation (including, without limitation, any laws regarding the export of data or software to and from the US or other countries).

(b) For the purpose of exploiting, harming, or attempting to exploit or harm minors in any way by exposing them to inappropriate content, asking for personally identifiable information, or otherwise.

**16. DISSATISFACTION.**

If you are unsatisfied with the BASE Materials, your sole remedy is to terminate these Terms of Use. We may terminate these Terms of Use, in whole or with respect to a Service, with or without cause, at any time immediately upon our disabling your Access Credentials. We may notify you of termination of the Terms of Use via e-mail or other written notice to the address you provide to us in the registration process. After the termination of these Terms of Use or a Service, you are not authorized to access or use the Service, and you shall cease all such access and use. If you nonetheless access or use the Service in spite of termination of the Terms of Use or Service, your use of, or access to, the Service will be subject to the version of the Terms of Use then in effect as to all current users.

**17. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION.**

All matters relating to the BASE Materials and these Terms of Use, and any dispute or claim arising therefrom or related thereto (in each case, including non-contractual disputes or claims), shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the internal laws of the State of Colorado without giving effect to any choice or conflict of law provision or rule (whether of the State of Colorado or any other jurisdiction). Any legal suit, action, or proceeding arising out of, or related to, these Terms of Use or the BASE Materials shall be instituted exclusively in the federal courts of the United States or the courts of the State of Colorado,

in each case located in the City of Denver and County of Denver. You waive any and all objections to the exercise of jurisdiction over you by such courts and to venue in such courts.

**18. ARBITRATION.**

At BASE Education’s sole discretion, it may require You to submit any disputes arising from these Terms of Use or use of the BASE Materials, including disputes arising from or concerning their interpretation, violation, invalidity, non-performance, or termination, to final and binding arbitration under the Rules of Arbitration of the American Arbitration Association applying Colorado law.

**19. LIMITATION ON TIME TO FILE CLAIMS.**

ANY CAUSE OF ACTION OR CLAIM YOU MAY HAVE ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THESE TERMS OF USE OR THE WEBSITE MUST BE COMMENCED WITHIN ONE (1) YEAR AFTER THE CAUSE OF ACTION ACCRUES; OTHERWISE, SUCH CAUSE OF ACTION OR CLAIM IS PERMANENTLY BARRED.

**20. MISCELLANEOUS.**
